Question 1: The proposed annual budget indicates an increase in revenues as a result of being awarded ticket share revenue from the City of East Orange. Revenues are also anticipated to increase due to the hiring of additional parking enforcement officers (PEO's). The proposed budget includes additional expenses (specifically to Payroll and consulting) which the Authority first incurred in the year 2017. The budget reflects an additional expense for hiring 3 PEO's as well as continuing to hire a part-time executive director. These expenses were inserted to specifically show the city of East Orange that it is imperative for the Authority to receive ticket share revenue and additional permit income if it expects to survive. After reviewing the proposed expenses, it is the recommendation of the board to receive no less than \$10 per written ticket as part of the ticket share from the City of East Orange.

Question 2: The proposed annual budget will have a significant positive impact on the Authority assuming that it receives ticket-share revenue from the city of East Orange. We feel that receiving ticket-share revenue from the City of East Orange will also be positive to the Authority because it will create additional jobs for the City of East Orange as more PEO's will be hired to do the overnight tickets and permits. Additionally, it is our recommendation to increase PEO salaries and Admin salaries. The additional wages will have a positive impact on all employees.

It is important to note the following revenue line items which have increased above the 10% threshold:

Meters - The Meter rate was increased from \$0.50 per hour to \$1.00 per hour citywide. The authority has installed new working pay stations at city hall and the library. These replace outdated and non-working pay stations.

Fines & Penalties – The increase is a result of the Authority receiving fine-sharing of \$10 per ticket paid to the Authority by the City of East Orange for every ticket issued and paid.

Interest – Interest is paid by the bank based on the available balance in each checking and savings account. The increase in Interest Income is a direct result of the additional revenue received.

Question 3: The state of the local economy has been unchanged for many years. The economical strength of the city remains low. No major shifts (positively or negatively) are expected for the region during the budget period.

Question 6: The proposed budget does not reflect an anticipated deficit from 2017 operations. No deficit reduction plan is required at this time.

Question 1: The proposed annual budget indicates an increase in revenues as a result of being awarded ticket share revenue from the City of East Orange. Revenues are also anticipated to increase due to the hiring of additional parking enforcement officers (PEO's). The proposed budget includes additional expenses (specifically to Payroll and consulting) which the Authority first incurred in the year 2017. The budget reflects an additional expense for hiring 3 PEO's as well as continuing to hire a part-time executive director. These expenses were inserted to specifically show the city of East Orange that it is imperative for the Authority to receive ticket share revenue and additional permit income if it expects to survive. After reviewing the proposed expenses it is the recommendation of the board to receive no less than \$10 per written ticket as part of the ticket share from the City of East Orange.

Question 2: The proposed annual budget will have a significant positive impact on the Authority assuming that it receives ticket-share revenue from the city of East Orange. We feel that receiving ticket-share revenue from the City of East Orange will also be positive to the Authority because it will create additional jobs for the City of East Orange as more PEO's will be hired to do the overnight tickets and permits. Additionally it is our recommendation to increase PEO salaries and Admin salaries. The additional wages will have a positive impact on all employees.

Question 3: The state of the local economy has been unchanged for many years. The economical strength of the city remains low. No major shifts (positively or negatively) are expected for the region during the budget period.

Question 6: The proposed budget does not reflect an anticipated deficit from 2017 operations. No deficit reduction plan is required at this time.
